'...this is our sons' first and probably last cruise...as a family we were delighted to have been asked, and the experience was thrilling and relaxing, a lovely memory to cherish...'


'...dogs got in the water and they looked like hippos!!...very funny...food was scrummy and the railway thingy was cool...'
